Shoe Collection

The **Faith & Justice Committee** is sponsoring the collection of new and used shoes — all kinds and sizes — for **Soles4Souls**, a global not-for-profit institution which fights poverty. They will distribute the shoes to qualified microenterprise programs in developing countries, programs designed to create jobs that create a sustained income for individuals and eventually a self-sufficient community.

The microenterprise participants clean and recondition the shoes to sell locally, thus providing both a rare employment opportunity to impoverished people and an affordable source of shoes for the impoverished local population.

Shoes in very poor condition are sent to recyclers in Pakistan who salvage the usable materials from the shoes.
