Non-members, neighbors and friends are invited to participate with our members in this effort.



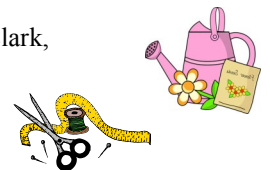


