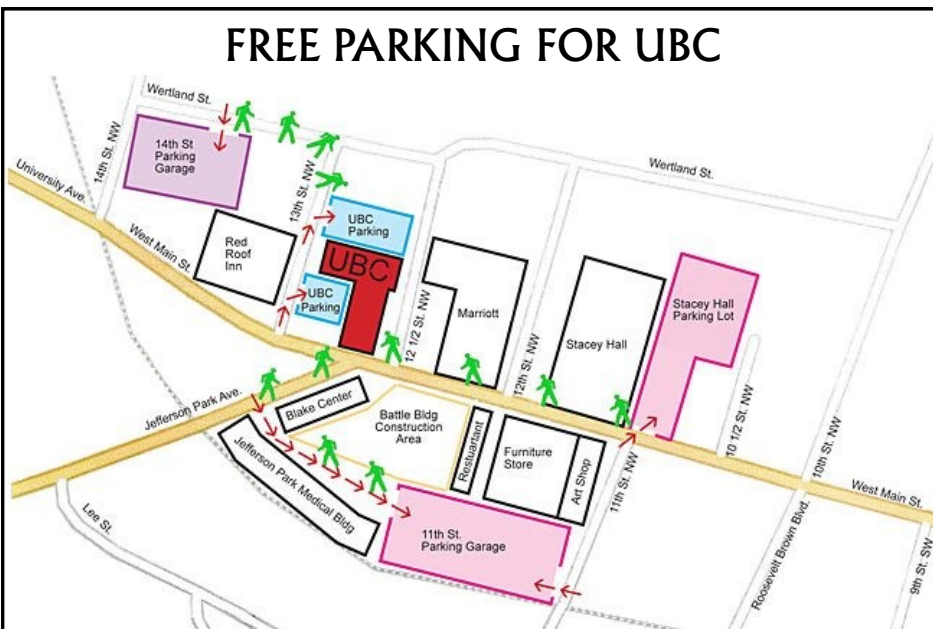

Alma Hunt Offering for Virginia Missions

During September we will be supporting the Alma Hunt Offering for Virginia Missions and the Chaplain Service Prison Ministry of Virginia, Inc. (specifically, Chaplain Julie Perry at the Fluvanna Correctional Center for Women).

The Chaplain Service has changed the lives of thousands of offenders throughout the Commonwealth of Virginia by distributing Bibles, conducting worship services, providing counseling and coordinating volunteer programs.



The Alma Hunt offering supports ministries in and missionaries from Virginia.

The annual offering for Virginia missions was named for Alma Hunt (1909-2008), a native Virginian who was known worldwide for her missions service and her unwavering dedication to the cause of Christ.

The offering provides funding for all WMUV (Woman's Missionary Union of Virginia) missions and ministries and makes possible other special ministries, outreach projects, and initiatives not funded through regular streams of giving, but uniquely connected to Virginia Baptists.

St. John's Bible

On Wednesday, September 17, at 6:15 pm, in Fellowship Hall, Tracy Hartman, professor at Baptist Theological Seminary at Richmond, will be displaying and talking about sections from The Saint John's Bible, the first Bible of its kind to be produced in 500 years. Smithsonian Magazine called this project "one of the most extraordinary undertakings of our time."
