A Word from Will Brown

I want to take this opportunity to update the congregation about the Ministry Residency program. As the first resident at UBC, part of my task is to help structure our program and give feedback about how to make changes. At a meeting with my Lay Support Team earlier this month, I suggested we implement a new rotation schedule for the residency, and the Lay Support Team helped refine how this will look.

While I will continue to perform a wide range of tasks, the rotation system will allow me to focus the residency's learning and reflection component on a particular aspect of ministry (such as pastoral care, education, worship, administration, etc.).

As I rotate through these areas in the months to come, I will be sharing my observations more regularly, both the

lessons I learn about myself and the insights I gain about UBC. At its best, a residency program like this helps a minister to grow and learn, but it also helps a church to grow and learn more about itself. I look forward to the conversations this will generate and the insights we will gain from each other. To facilitate these discussions, one of our Wednesday night sessions later this spring will be devoted to the residency program. This will be a time when you will hear more from me about what I've been doing, and we will all have the chance to talk about it together. In the meantime, I will be sharing some of my reflections in *The Word* and on our website, and I hope you will not hesitate to share your thoughts with me as well. I'm excited about what we will be learning together!
