This spring we will be combining the two events into ... (drum roll, please) ... “**Operation Mission Madness**”!! The weekend of April 17-19, UBC will be a host church for this year’s Mission Madness event. More than 250 youth from churches around Virginia will flock to Charlottesville to worship here at the church and to engage in a day of service in our community.

As the host church, we will be able to serve alongside the youth at work sites

in and around Charlottesville, as we have each year in the past with OIAM. However, we will also have additional responsibilities, and we are hoping UBC members are willing to accept the challenge! We will need groups to prepare meals for 250 youth on Friday and Saturday, and we will need UBC representatives to be leaders at each work site!

We will be discussing the specifics of this weekend during our Wednesday night Town Hall meeting this week. Join us then to learn more, ask questions, and discover how you can be involved in making Operation Mission Madness a success this year, as we join with hundreds of youth to make an impact in our community!

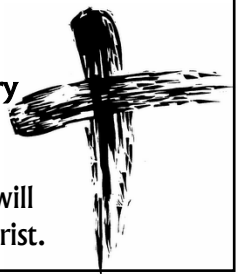

Interfaith Prayer Service at UVa

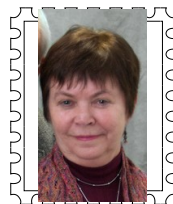
