CBF supports a wide range of missions and ministries that give people meaningful opportunities to put their faith to action, including a network of 125 field personnel ministering in more than 30 countries.



Over the past decade, Paynter has gained a national reputation for her advocacy on important ethical issues such as religious liberty, hunger and poverty, human trafficking and immigration reform. An ordained deacon and Sunday school teacher of more than 40 years, Paynter has held positions of leadership in Baptist churches in Texas, Kentucky and Mississippi.

Dr. John Upton to Speak This Wednesday

Dr. John V. Upton, Jr. will be our Wednesday Night speaker on February 25. Dr. Upton is the Executive Director of the Baptist General Association of Virginia (BGAV), a position that he has held since November of 2001. He is also currently serving a five-year term as President of the Baptist World Alliance (BWA) that began July 31, 2010.



A Norfolk-born Virginia native, Dr. Upton is a graduate of Averett College (now University) in Danville, VA and Southern Baptist Theological Seminary in Louisville, KY.

Dr. Upton will speak on the work of the BGAV and the BWA, both organizations receiving UBC’s contributions through our budget.

Blake Tommey to Speak March 4



Blake Tommey will be our Wednesday Night speaker on March 4. Blake is the director of Eunoia, the Baptist Collegiate Ministry at the University of Virginia. As a collegiate minister and Jesus follower, he has a passion for discerning where God is already at work, especially in the lives of young people who are unchurched or on the margins of faith. Blake seeks to engage young people in the life of a creative Christ community and empower young leaders to do the same as they follow God’s call on their lives.

In addition to vocational ministry, Blake is a gifted writer and musician. As a freelance writer, he contributes regularly to various faith publications and is a folk singer-songwriter who plays the banjo, guitar, piano, and sings. He has a fierce love for the church, the Avett Brothers, the poetry of Wendell Berry, international food, the South, Harry Potter novels, bluegrass music, movies, hiking and skiing.
