There is also an adapted VBS program for UBC toddlers/preschoolers.

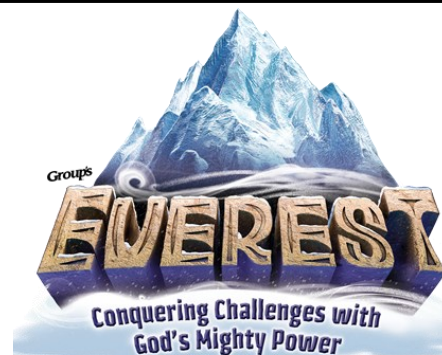
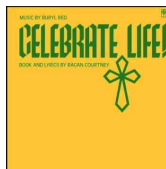
