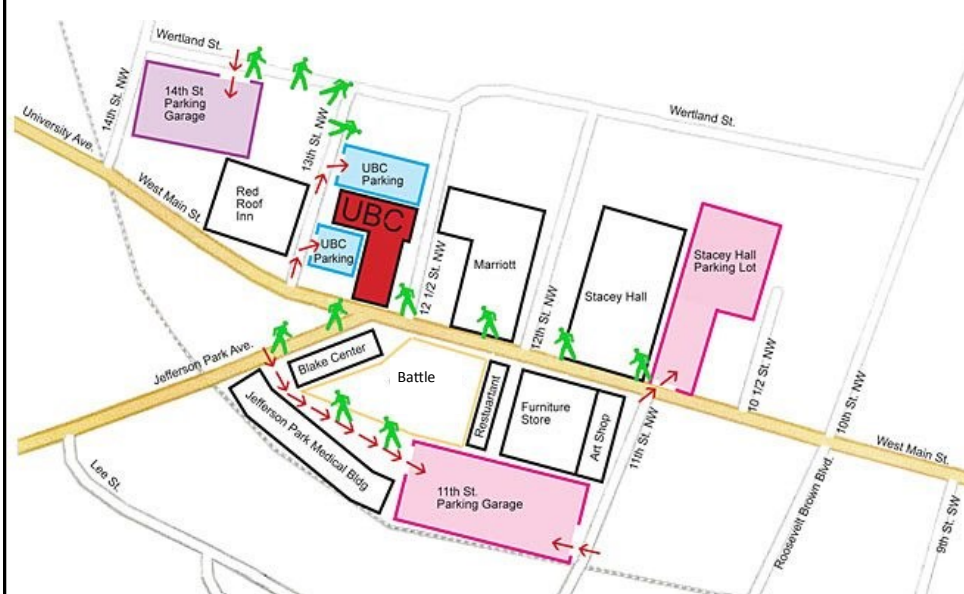

Alma Hunt Offering for Virginia Missions

During September we will be supporting the Alma Hunt Offering for Virginia Missions. This offering supports ministries in and missionaries from Virginia.



The annual offering for Virginia Missions was named for Alma Hunt (1909-2008), a native Virginian who was known worldwide for her missions service and her unswerving dedication to the cause of Christ.

The offering provides funding for all WMUV (Woman's Missionary Union of Virginia) missions and ministries and makes possible other special ministries, outreach projects, and initiatives not funded through regular streams of giving, but uniquely connected to Virginia Baptists. Since 1976 the offering has been a joint venture between WMUV and the Baptist General Association of Virginia (BGAV).
