Leadership Transition Team

The Leadership Transition Team (LTT) held its first meeting on Sunday, January 31, and elected Brent Wilson as Chair and Jocelyn Brumbaugh as Vice Chair. The LTT will:

- Recommend the interim model for UBC to follow while we are without a Senior Minister
- Recommend when a Senior Minister Search Committee should be formed
- Work with the Personnel Committee to develop a list of characteristics of the Senior Minister to be recruited
- Recommend whether or not a consultant is needed to manage this transition
- Recommend when the vacant Associate Minister position should be filled

The team will meet regularly, advise Church Council, consult with the Deacons, and submit a report to the congregation for a vote.
