Faith & Justice Committee Update

Last fall, a handful of UBC members attended the IMPACT annual assembly. We learned about IMPACT's recent efforts to address the need for local residential therapy options for those struggling with substance addiction/abuse. We heard a report from the director of Region 10 regarding plans to build a new residential recovery facility that will serve women and their families. Currently, if women in this area need residential treatment, the nearest facility is 70 miles away, and if women want to remain with their children, the closest option for residential treatment is Virginia Beach. The Director explained that the new facility will be able to serve about 50 women each year, and will offer wrap-around services for other physical, mental, vocational and transportation needs. The land and developer have been secured, and Region 10 plans to have the facility open in January 2017!

Looking ahead, one of the big concerns brought to IMPACT's attention through their listening process is elder care in our community. Preliminary research has shown that many people in our area are struggling to care for themselves, their spouses, and aging parents, relatives, or neighbors. Many elders have health problems that are very costly, and many seniors find themselves having to work into their retirement years in order to afford to live. In the Charlottesville area, nearly 1 in 10 seniors live on an income less than \$11K per year. For those reasons, in 2016 IMPACT plans to focus on meeting community needs in the area of elder care. Their work and research has begun. More information will be shared at the Nehemiah Action meeting May 3 at 6:30 pm at the Martin Luther King Jr. Performing Arts Center. Everyone is invited to join with other congregations to show our support for bringing justice in our community for seniors and those struggling with substance abuse/addiction.

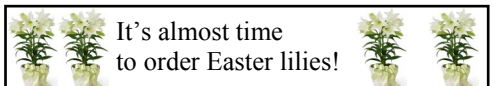
