Leadership Transition Update

At the Called Church Conference on March 6, the church approved the LTT and Church Council's recommendation to hire an Interim Minister and to begin forming the Senior Minister Search Committee. Since then, the LTT has been working diligently with our denominational associations and ministry connections, including Baptist General Association of Virginia, Cooperative Baptist Fellowship, and Center for Healthy Churches, to find suitable candidates for the Interim Minister position. The LTT, with input and involvement from our ministers, staff, and the Personnel Committee, are currently evaluating these candidates.

The LTT is optimistic that we will be able to make an Interim Minister recommendation to Church Council, the Deacons, and the Personnel Committee by April 3. With that in mind, we have asked that another Called Church Conference be planned for Wednesday, April 13, in anticipation of being able to present this recommendation to the congregation. With church approval, it is our goal that an Interim Minister will be hired during April. In short, we are trying to move as efficiently and effectively as possible!

The team recognizes that this is a crucial and important stage in the life of UBC, and we are making plans prayerfully. As always, we welcome and invite any and all questions or comments. Please let us know your thoughts and considerations. We are excited about the opportunities that God is presenting to UBC!
