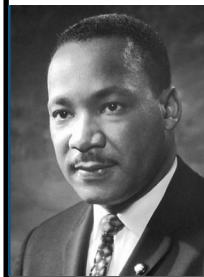

Dr. Bill Wilson to Speak at UBC January 15



Dr. William “Bill” Wilson founded the Center for Healthy Churches in January 2014. This followed his service as President of the Center for Congregational Health at Wake Forest Baptist Health since 2009. Bill brings over 33 years of local church ministry experience to CHC, having served long-term pastorates in two churches in Virginia and on a church staff in South Carolina. He led each of the churches he served into a time of significant growth and expansion of ministry. His denominational leadership has been extensive, including serving as the President of the Baptist General Association of Virginia in 1998. Dr. Wilson is a certified coach and facilitator and has experience as a consultant in numerous settings. He is currently assisting the UBC Senior Minister Search Committee in its work.

The Crestmen to Lead in Worship January 22

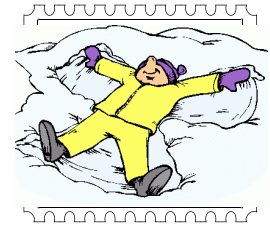
