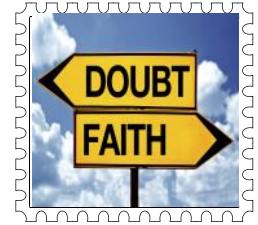

Do You Use the UBC Kitchen?

PLEASE. LEAVE. IT. CLEAN!

Everyone who uses our church kitchen is responsible for cleaning it up afterwards. This includes:

- **Wiping** counters, microwaves inside & out, stoves, refrigerators, freezers, tables in Fellowship Hall if used, spills on the floor
- **Washing, Drying & Putting away** dishes and utensils
- **Running** the dishwasher if necessary
- **Emptying** trash cans if necessary
- **Throwing away** unused tea & lemonade
- **Washing** dish towels, etc. (Don’t use the UBC washing machine if you can’t stay to dry the items.)
- **Putting** leftovers in disposable pans and taking them with you
- **Storing** large quantities of leftovers properly (labeled, frozen) or donating to Hospitality House
- **Writing** on board if using last of something (check pantry first) or marking one of the inventory sheets
