Being Light in Dark Days

Matthew 7:24-25, "Everyone then who hears these words of mine and acts on them will be like a wise person who built a house on rock. The rain fell, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house, but it did not fall, because it had been founded on a rock."

Today is a rainy Monday. Yet, I do not feel like I am living in Karen Carpenter's song. She sang, "Rainy days and Mondays always get me down . . ." Instead, my mind drifts to Edward Mote's hymn, "My Hope is Built on Nothing Less," especially the refrain, "On Christ, the solid Rock, I stand; All other ground is sinking sand."

The foundation for the church is Jesus Christ. We hear Jesus' words recounted in the gospels, and we seek to live by them. Living and acting on Jesus' words transforms our lives.
