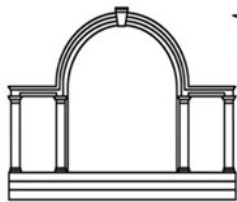

THE CHILDREN'S SERMON

(Children's Church will not meet today)

THE LITANY based on Romans 8:23-32, 39-39 (NCV)

Leader: We have been waiting with this great hope aborning within us. We have the Spirit as the first part of God's promise, and we are waiting for God to finish making us God's own children, which means our bodies will be made free.

People: We were saved, and we have this hope: we are hoping for something we do not have yet, and we are waiting for it patiently.

Leader: The Spirit helps us with our weakness. We do not know how to pray as we should.

People: But the same Spirit speaks to God for us, even begs God for us with deep feelings that words cannot explain.

Leader: God can see what is in people's hearts. And he knows what is in the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit speaks to God for us exactly in the way God wants.

People: We know that in everything God works for the good of those of us who love him. We are the people called of God, just as God always planned.

Leader: God knew us before making the world, and choosing us to be like his Son so that Jesus would be the firstborn of many brothers and sisters.

People: God planned for us to be like his Son; and those whom God planned to be like his Son, he also called; and those whom God called, he also made right with him; and those whom God made right, he also glorified.

Leader: So what should we say about this? If God is for us, no one can defeat us. He did not spare his own Son but gave him for us all. So with Jesus, God will surely give us all things.

People: We are sure that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor ruling spirits, nothing now, nothing in the future, no powers, nothing above us, nothing below us, nor anything else in the whole world will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

THE OLD TESTAMENT LESSON Ruth 1:11-18 (NIV)

¹¹ But Naomi said, "Return home, my daughters. Why would you come with me? Am I going to have any more sons, who could become your husbands?"

¹² Return home, my daughters; I am too old to have another husband. Even if I thought there was still hope for me — even if I had a husband tonight and then gave birth to sons — ¹³ would you wait until they grew up? Would you remain unmarried for them? No, my daughters. It is more bitter for me than for you, because the Lord's hand has turned against me!"

¹⁴ At this they wept aloud again. Then Orpah kissed her mother-in-law goodbye, but Ruth clung to her.

¹⁵ "Look," said Naomi, "your sister-in-law is going back to her people and her gods. Go back with her."

¹⁶ But Ruth replied, "Don't urge me to leave you or to turn back from you. Where you go I will go, and where you stay I will stay. Your people will be my people and your God my God. ¹⁷ Where you die I will die, and there I will be buried. May the Lord deal with me, be it ever so severely, if even death separates you and me." ¹⁸ When Naomi realized that Ruth was determined to go with her, she stopped urging her.
