LITANY

People: Lord, You are my Shepherd. I shall not want.

Leader: In the dark and cloudy day that you were scattered, I sought you out to deliver you from places of chaos, devastation, panic, and fear.

People: Lord, You are my Shepherd. I shall not want. You, Lord, are my light and my salvation: whom shall I fear? You are the strength of my life: of whom shall I be afraid?
