What a Wonderful World

This Sunday, we will begin a five-week series celebrating God's wonderful world. There's so much bad news—so much death and destruction, environmental catastrophes, people hurting one another, and more. Sometimes it feels like too much. In the spirit of Easter, we are going to focus our attention on some of the stories of new life, wonder, and hope for the future.

Amazing stories surround us. So, instead of a series on food insecurity or the environment (those are coming in July and September, respectively), our themes will, I hope, be uplifting. This Sunday, our service will center on the disciple who encountered Jesus while walking to Emmaus (Luke 24:13-35). On April 23, we will look at Jesus' discussion with Nicodemus, focusing on John 3:16-21. On April 30, Jesus tells us not to worry and says, "Look at the birds of the air; they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them" (Matthew 6:25-34). Braxton Kemp will be our guest preacher on May 7, and he will remind us that God is with us even when we don't notice God's presence (Matthew 13:1-9). Our series will end on May 14 with the reminder that we are a blessing to one another (Psalm 150).

Being thankful and looking at the beauty all around us doesn't mean we are ignoring more difficult topics. They are still there. Jesus told his disciples, "You always have the poor with you," in Matthew 26:11. This wasn't to let us off the hook to help others. He had just told them,
