In church life, we talk about what gives us joy. We focus on God's eternal love surrounding us, and our focus can be quite personal. This is the inward part of faith and our encounter with the risen Christ. It's important, and we shouldn't lose sight of God's presence in our lives.

The other side of the coin is the outward part of faith. What do we do with God's love when we experience it? God doesn't call us to keep our divine experiences as holy secrets. We experience God, and then we share that experience in many different ways.

One of the ways we can share God's love is by serving in the church. On Sunday, we prayed for our Nominating Committee, and we prayed for God to guide us to find the places to serve that give us the most joy. Being active in the church is an outward expression of the faith we have inside. It's a way of responding to God on a regular basis, and right now there are some great opportunities to serve.

Here is a list of some of these opportunities and a brief explanation of how this might bring you joy.

• Moderator – This person helps us maintain our focus on Christ during church conferences. It is a ministry of listening and directing. The moderator is part of the church council and integral to God's mission at UBC. Any member who feels called can serve as the moderator, and no experience is required.

Church Council – Once a month, the Church Council meets at 8:30 on a Sunday morning. The council members and ministers discuss the life of the church. We

look at our vision and ask how our church events help support this mission. When we consider a new idea, the Church Council discusses and helps shape it. The Church Council is responsible for live streaming, UniBap Park, the ice cream ministry, and much, much more.

- Finance Committee We need to pay for everything we do. On the third Sunday of each month, the Finance Committee meets to discuss the church's revenue, expenses, endowment income, budget projections, and any endowment requests. The finances enable God's ministries at UBC to continue.
- Personnel Committee This committee seeks to serve and support our staff. The Personnel Committee celebrates milestones, provides help when we need to hire someone, and ensures the church is taking care of its employees. They discuss goals with the ministers and encourage us as we seek to do God's work. This is a committee for people who want to help our staff be the best they can be.
- Children's Ministry Team We need 2-3 people to help lead our children's ministry. Last year, we said that children are our top priority. We need someone to begin thinking about VBS 2024. We need people to help organize special opportunities for children. We need volunteers for all of those events.
- Development Team Although "development" is just the new/cool word for stewardship, there is something different about how we are approaching giving in the twenty-first century. We want to take a holistic approach to giving and need a small group to help direct our stewardship efforts. This team will work with the ministers to incorporate giving testimonies in worship and explore different ways to keep the conversation about supporting what we love going.
- Youth Ministry Team This team will work with Val to support her in our youth ministry. The members of the team can be volunteers or planners or both. We want to give our young people a transformational experience in Christ, so they become life-long followers of Jesus. To do this, they need to have fun, learn about their faith, eat, study the Bible, and eat some more. Val is an incredible resource and will guide this team.
- College, Youth, & Children's ministry volunteers, Wednesday Work Crew, Ushers & Greeters, and More Picture my folded hands and imagine me saying, "Here's the church. Here's the steeple.
