On Sunday, January 5, we invited each person to pick a paper star from a basket. I wrote about these "start words" in this space last week. During that service, our Old Testament lesson came from Isaiah 60:1, "Arise, shine, for your light has come." The "star words" are a chance for us to take the light we've received and shine it forth for other people. If you haven't come by the office to pick one up for 2025, you still can.

This week, I am thinking about PACEM, our upcoming budget discussion, our ambitious perception of God's calling, and upcoming youth and college events. As my mind spirals around the continuing signs of vibrant life at UBC, I look back at the word I drew from the basket. It makes me think about what God could be saying to me through that particular word. Then, I thought about another word, a word that could apply to our entire church family: invitation.

You are part of this church family, because someone invited you. Even if you somewhat randomly decided to visit UBC, you made it your church home, because someone invited you to join. Beyond giving thanks for those who invited you to the life in Christ you now enjoy, consider who you could invite? Who might enjoy what we do? For example, are you planning to help with PACEM? If so, do you know someone who feels compassion for unhoused people and might be interested in volunteering with PACEM, too? We plan to offer a blessing for the PACEM volunteers during worship this

As a church, we follow Jesus when we invite others to be part of what we're doing. When we think of potential "star words" or guiding principles, creating a culture of invitation is close to the spirit of Jesus' calling.

Who is someone in your orbit who might enjoy something we're doing at UBC? How can you invite them to join us? If you have ideas, share them with me or others in the church. Together, we can learn, grow, and build an invitational culture.
