necessary to join? Why not join? Most importantly, why join?

Defining the different categories in our database would be nice, but it isn't an essential prerequisite for following Christ. In Matthew 4:18-22, Jesus invited Simon, Andrew, James, and John to follow him. Saying, "Yes," to that invitation to "leave our nets" and follow Jesus is the essential step. We have agency, and we get to decide whether or not we want to make Jesus Lord of our lives.

As Christ-followers, we join with other Christ-followers, and together, we form a family of faith. That's what the church is, and that is what UBC aspires to be. We never intended to be a club with rules and membership lists. Yet this structure and these lists help us organize and make it easier for us to accomplish Jesus' work in our community. Still, we should never lose sight of our calling to be a family of faith where all are welcome.

Joining is a statement of belonging. It's like saying, "I believe in what this family of faith believes, and I want to state publicly that this people is my people" (cf. Ruth 1:16). However, there's no pressure to join. If one doesn't feel the Holy Spirit leading down the aisle to make such a statement, that's okay. One of the aspects of being part of the family of faith at UBC is the recognition that everyone is at a different place on their journey.

Whether you've joined or not, I am glad you are part of our family at UBC, and I look forward to continuing to walk in faith with you.
