For the next several weeks, we will be collecting donations for the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship offering for National Missions. Our UBC Missions Council has chosen to send our offering directly to CBF field personnel The Reverend Scarlette Jasper who serves the people of Appalachia in Kentucky. The CBF commissioned Jasper as a field personnel in 2014. She subsequently earned a Master of Divinity degree from Baptist Seminary of Kentucky with a concentration in pastoral care and counseling, sharpening her skills for a lifelong call to ministry.

Scarlett has been serving an area that covers south -central and southeastern Kentucky and eastern

125 Years Ago

From the first page of the Minute Book: "A large number of the brethren and sisters who withdrew from the Charlottesville Baptist Church on

Thursday evening Sept. 27th by letters met at the Levy Opera House on October 4th, 1900 for the purpose of organizing a New Baptist Church at 8 PM." With these words, the congregation that would become University Baptist Church was born. "After singing a familiar hymn, Dr. Tribble read the 19th Psalm and then offered up a very touching prayer". Fifty-five individuals were in attendance at that meeting and thirty others submitted letters in advance.
