He has authored numerous articles and seven books including, *Crisis Ministry: A Handbook* and *Beyond The Myths: The Journey To Adulthood* (2007).

Dan has preached at UBC many times and has taught numerous sessions here on Wednesday evenings.

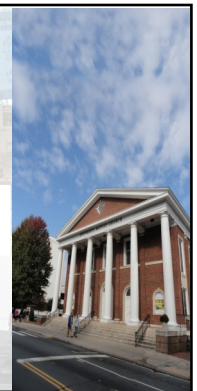
