A Word from Michael

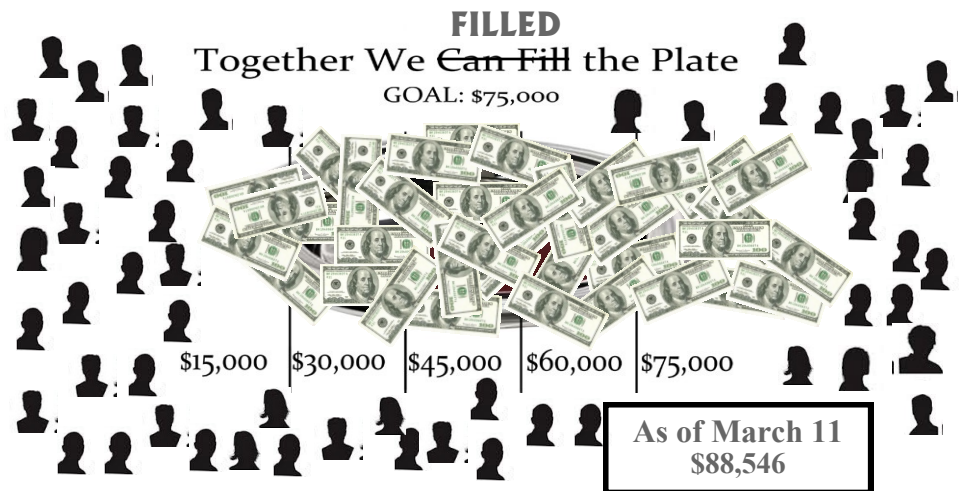
