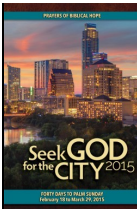

Rob Fox to Speak Wednesday, March 11

Rob Fox will be our Wednesday Night speaker on March 11 at 6:15 pm in Fellowship Hall. Rob is a native Virginian and a long time Baptist minister. He is a graduate of Baptist Theological Seminary at Richmond (BTSR) and was ordained to the gospel ministry in 1996 by Culpeper Baptist Church. Rob has

served in ministry roles in five churches in Virginia, and as an administrator in two seminaries during his seventeen years of ministry. He currently serves as field coordinator for CBF Virginia. Rob assists 350 churches in Virginia as they connect with CBF mission and ministries.

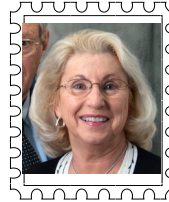
Dr. Ronald Crawford to Speak March 18



Ron Crawford, President of BTSR, will be our Wednesday Night speaker on March 18 at 6:15 pm in Fellowship Hall. Prior to becoming BTSR’s second president in 2007, Ron served as pastor for 27 years, including congregations in Virginia, North Carolina, and Florida. While in Virginia, Dr. Crawford served as president of the Baptist General Association of Virginia and as president of the Virginia Baptist General Board.

A graduate of North Carolina State University, Crawford earned his Master of Divinity degree in 1977 and his Doctor of Ministry degree in 1985, both from Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary. In 1993, he earned his Master of Public Administration from Virginia Commonwealth University.
