Update from JARC

Last Wednesday night, JARC (Joint Administrative Review Committee) presented an update on our work to update UBC's Constitution, By-Laws, and Leadership Manual. One of the most significant proposed changes involves our Committees, Councils, and Teams, which would now be structured differently.

Committees would remain basically the same as they are now, but there would be fewer of them. The number of Councils (which have some members predetermined based on their other leadership positions) would also shrink. Beyond these, other groups in the church would be Teams, which will be defined more flexibly. Church Council would be able to create or remove Teams as needed. People in the church would be able to join or leave Teams

whenever they like, without going through a process of being nominated and elected.

Enclosed in this issue of the Word (and attached to the email) is a handout from Wednesday night. It lists the current Committees/Councils/Teams and those proposed in the new system. It also includes a chart to help distinguish between these groups.

None of these changes is set in stone. We are still actively working to craft the best system we can. Please contact any member of JARC with your concerns or suggestions: Will Brown, Shirley Clark, Jim Hallissy, Alan Hendricks, and Amanda Ohlms. There will also be opportunities for further discussion in the coming weeks, before a final vote at a Church Conference.
