## State Missions Offering

This fall offering will go to Cooperative Baptist Fellowship (CBF) field personnel (missionaries) Sue and Greg Smith. The Smiths are serving the first-generation Latino immigrant community located in Fredericksburg, VA, through a CBF mission that they founded called LUCHA Ministries. LUCHA is the Spanish word for "fight" or "struggle."

The Smiths' ministry goals center on helping Latino immigrant families to live better, healthier, more productive lives in the United States, with opportunities to integrate fully into their communities.

Greg and Sue's programs that foster sustainable self-sufficiency include:

- hunger relief services for immigrant families
- women's empowerment program featuring classes to train and equip Latinas in skills that can be used for personal and family support
- literacy, ESOL, and mentoring program for children and parents
- low-cost immigration legal assistance
- bilingual counseling and pastoral care






This group will be traveling to Haiti to begin forming relationships with the goal of finding long-term partners for missions.
