On Sunday evenings, for years, a group of Spanish-speaking Baptists have gathered at UBC for worship and fellowship. We welcome this group and provide space for them. We are thankful to God for our church, and we can bless God by being a blessing to others. You are welcome to attend the Spanish-language worship on Sunday evenings at 6:00 PM.

Too often, we focus on our own activities. We know what we are doing, and we miss what other groups are doing in the church. When someone says, "I had no idea we did that," I can see the need for better communication. In the church office, we are trying to improve our communication.

We have building/community-use and church-use layers for a Google calendar. Both are available to view in the church office, and within the next two months, a kiosk in the hall outside the office will display both calendars. To see what is happening and who is using the church, we can look at this digital calendar.

Among the staff, we are forming a plan to ensure better communication. We will use The Word, email, Facebook, YouTube, the video screens in the halls (and someday in the sanctuary), and anything else we can find.

Our goal is to make sure everyone knows what is happening. When we know what is happening, we can get involved. We can volunteer and grow through the life of the church. And, we can invite friends to join us. How can you invite someone to come with you to an event that you did not know was happening?

What else? Be engaged. Ask questions. Email me or another member of the staff. For instance, did you know that the UVA undergraduate Bible study has started. Last week, we had three students gather in my office. We studied Mark 3:21-30 in depth. They are bright young people and plan to return.
