FLOWERS

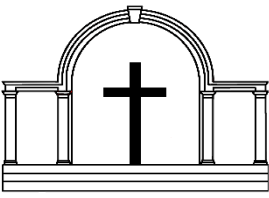
The palms have been arranged in the sanctuary by our Floral Team for Palm Sunday.
