FLOWERS

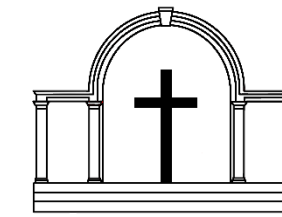

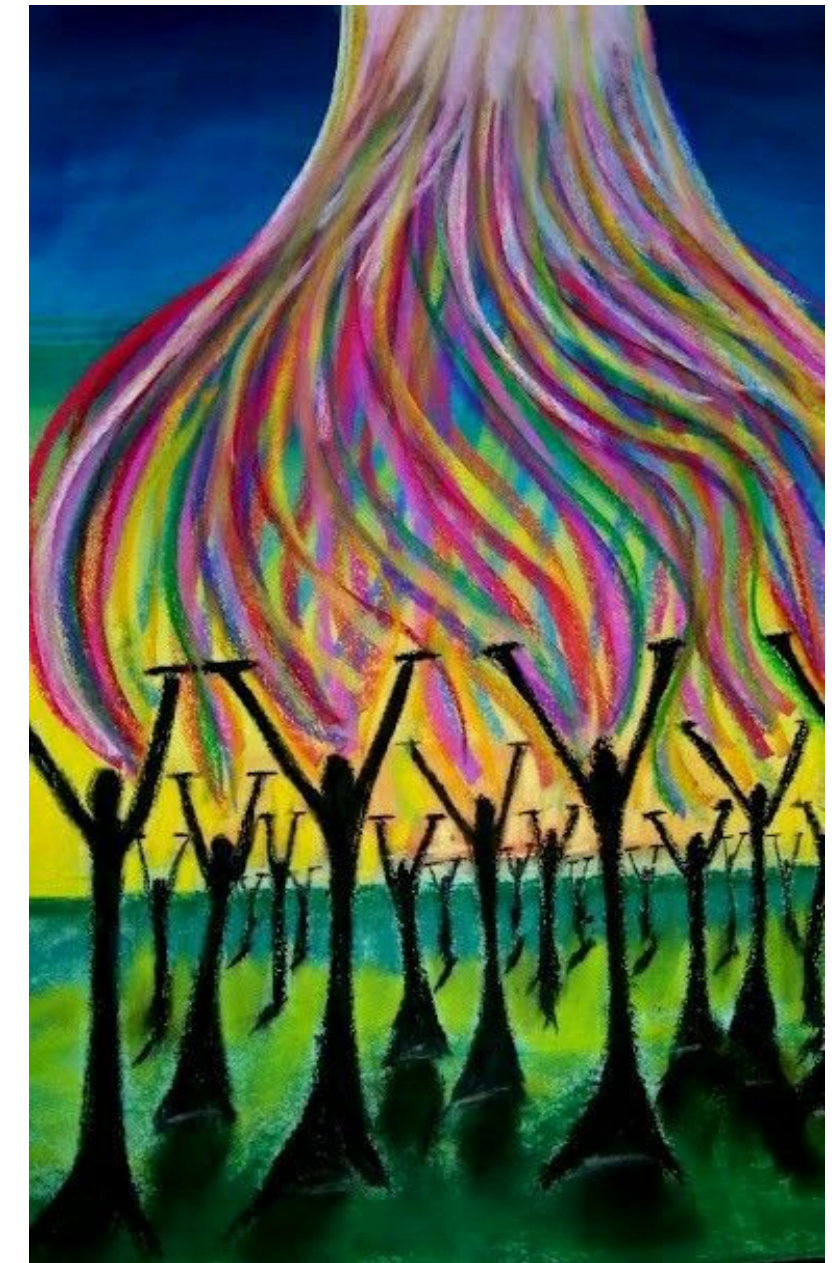
