When I asked her if anyone invited her to a class, she said no. She likes the church. The people have been friendly. And, she plans to keep coming. I cannot understand why no one has invited her to their Bible study.

As we walked around the church, she was amazed at the space, and we did not even make it up to the third floor. What about you? Have you explored your church? Have you been to the old boiler room (aka the dungeon)? Have you seen the room with all of the pumps and piping for the glycol-based heat pump system?

Our church is a fascinating place. Setting aside the rooms and machinery, UBC is filled with meaning. The music pouring out of the Choir/Lecture Suite on Wednesday evenings can inspire God's speech in one's heart. When Barbara practices the organ on weekdays, the sanctuary comes alive. Or, sitting in the silence of the empty sanctuary elicits the movement of the Holy Spirit. On Tuesdays, the work crew performs various maintenance. Theirs is a labor of love. Watching them (or joining them) means participating in keeping up God's house.

I am happy to report that, after starting with 8 Jubilate members returning, we have doubled in size! We are now up to 16, and we will continue to recruit throughout this semester. We made contacts with 60+ students who expressed an interest in Jubilate at the Fall Activities fair on grounds the day before classes began. We also made another 60+ contacts to students who expressed an interest in choral singing during the student orientations this summer. We have one student from Ghana, one from China and another from Sweden. I am meeting with 6 of the members in individual lessons because they have never sung in a choir and musical notation is not familiar to them. Please pray for Jubilate as we continue to grow!

Building Hosts


