A Word from Will

Sing to the Lord a New Song—and an Old One

Sitting on my piano at home is the 1991 Baptist Hymnal, my name imprinted in gold on the cover. Because I was six years old when this hymnal came out, and because my church was an early adopter, this is the hymnal of my childhood. It was from this hymnal that I learned the words to “Great Is Thy Faithfulness” and “Be Thou My Vision” and “Come, Thou Fount of Every Blessing.” Since childhood I could tell you that “Amazing Grace” is on page 330, “Joy to the World” on page 87, and my grandfather’s name on page x of the Introduction (he was on a committee that helped assemble this hymnal).

The Baptist Hymnal is a book I love and cherish, and always will. Yet as I reflect on this hymnal, I also understand that it took the place of another beloved hymnal, a predecessor that holds this same stature for the generation before. Each hymnal brings new hymn texts, new tunes, and new ways of singing praise to the same, unchanging God.

For the last few years, we have regularly included copies of newer hymns in our worship bulletins. Our worship is enriched by the contributions of contemporary poets and hymn writers, the inclusion of new tunes from beyond the western world, and texts written from new perspectives. These hymns have come from several newer hymnals, most frequently the hymnal, *Glory to God*. It is this hymnal that Matt mentioned last week as a possible new hymnal for UBC.

Does this mean we set aside the older texts? Of course not. All the hymns I mentioned above are still included—how could they not be? Rather, we add new voices alongside the old, incorporating the best of the new hymns into the favorites we know by heart. Please to continue to pray with us about this decision, asking how we can best facilitate the worship of our
