The UniBap Pocket Park design competition has been going for the last four months, and people from all over the world have expressed interest in submitting a design. In the end, we had nine complete submissions. On Sunday, November 3, 2019, three judges, a representative from the City of Charlottesville Board of Architectural Review (BAR), and I met to decide a winner. UBC will use the winning design to construct a pocket park. The winner(s) will receive a \$1,000 donation to the charity of their choice.

And the winner is... Richard Price, a building information modeling (BIM) engineer from Ridge & Partners LLP in the United Kingdom. Richard describes his design, "The crux of my design is based around the early Christian symbol of the 'ichthys' (a.k.a 'The Jesus Fish') which means 'Jesus Christ, Son of God'."



His design is two ichthys intertwined around the three existing mature trees.

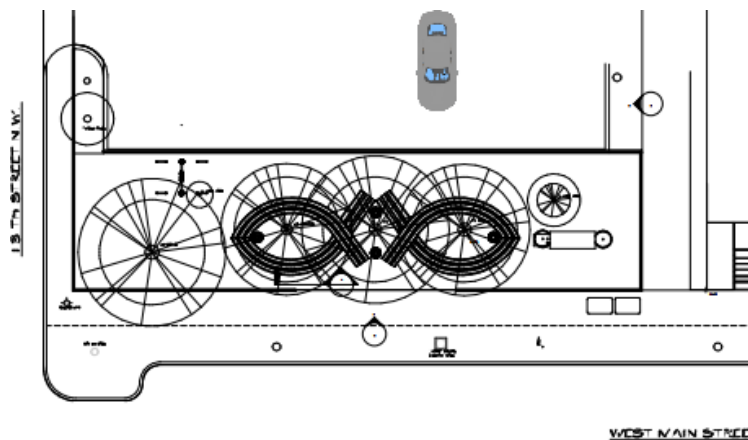

- Postage stamps

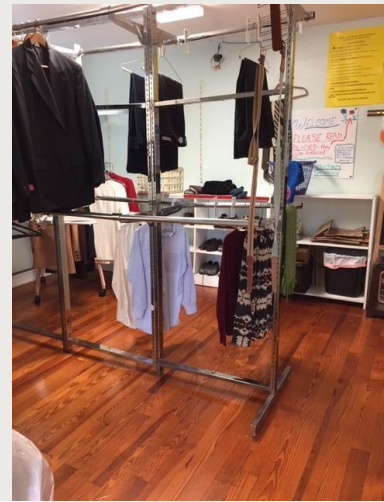


## CVBA in need of men's clothing!
