 'Tis an o-cean vast of bless-ing, 'Tis a ha-ven sweet of rest.

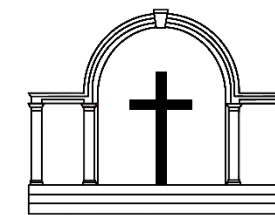
Un-derneath me, all a-round me, Is the cur-rent of Thy love;

 And it lifts me up to glo-ry, For it lifts me up to Thee.

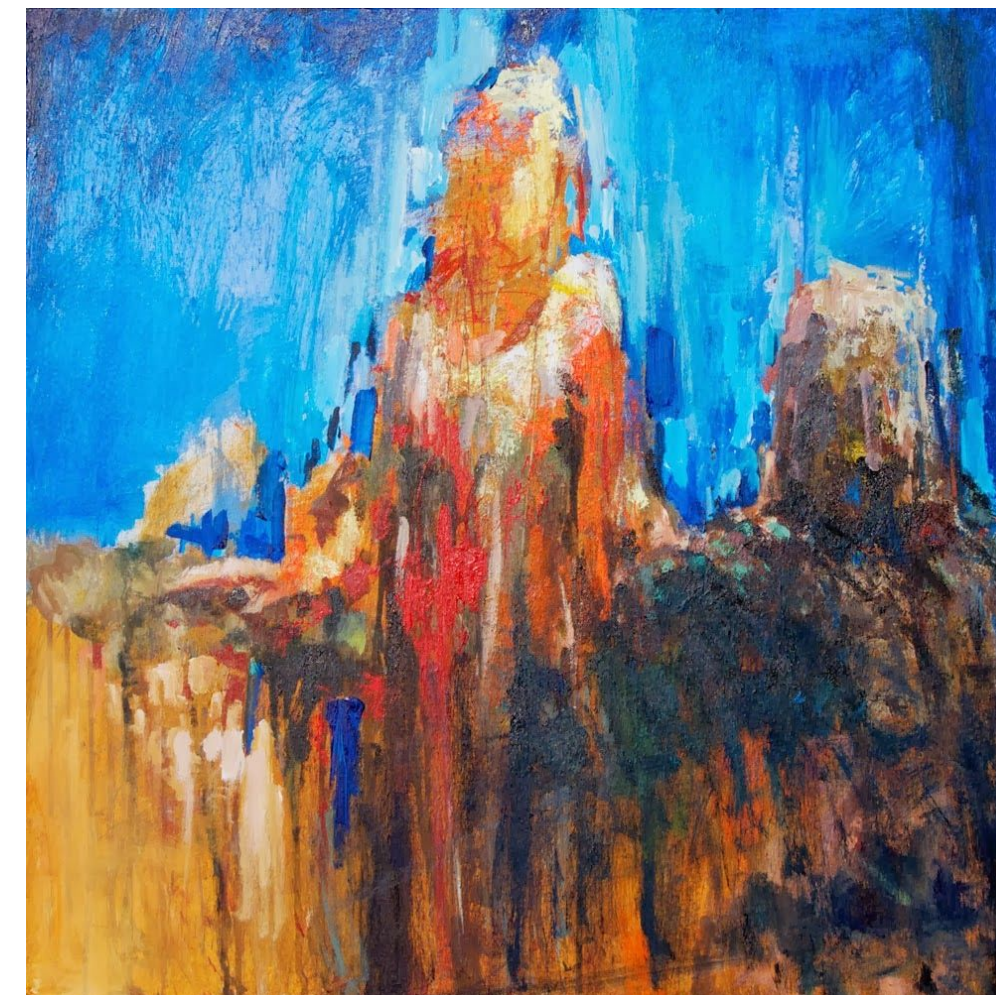
