Exciting Times Ahead

We have a big weekend ahead of us at UBC. We are calling a new Associate Minister. The excitement builds because this is a new position full of wonderful opportunities. We can look ahead and dream about what it will mean to our church to have someone dedicated to youth and college students. It's doubly thrilling because the candidate is relatively new in ministry!



One factor threatens to undermine the enthusiasm: COVID-19. We can't have a call-weekend the way we usually do. Instead, we have a week filled with Zoom video conferences. The candidate has to endure repeated questions (she's okay with that) and seeing people in squares on a screen instead of in real life (she understands and is okay with that too). We have to get to know her on paper and on the screen instead of in person.

This has not been the usual call process. The search committee has never met in person, which begs the question: can future committees include members who cannot be at the church? Can Bible studies meet online when it is convenient for participants. I think the COVID-era shows us many new ways to approach living for Christ in the future. It will shape how we participate in the church family in the future.

I hope you are looking forward to meeting the candidate and participating in the Church Conference this week. This is an exciting time in the life of the church, and I am glad we are walking together in it—even if this journey includes live
