God saw all that he had made, and it was very good — Genesis 1:31 NIV


1. I sing the might-y pow'r of God, That made the moun-tains rise,

And ev - 'ry - where that we can be, Thou, God, art pres - ent there.


The Solid Rock




1. My hope is built on noth-ing less Than Je-sus' love and righ-teous-ness;
