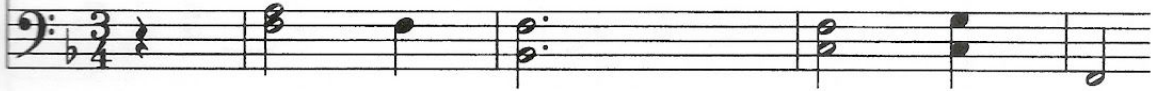

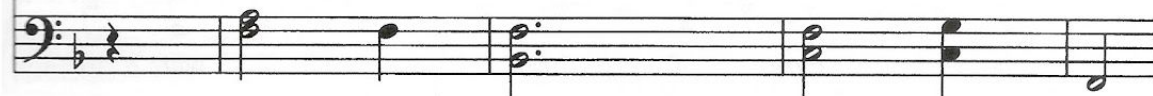
# Come Away from Rush and Hurry
