## Adjusting Plans for the Fall

We have long been looking to the fall as a hopeful season when the church would return to more of its pre-pandemic routines. However, with the rise of the Delta variant, we must be wise and exercise caution in our planning. Please read these updates carefully and contact our staff if you have any questions.

### This Wednesday Night: Meeting but No Dinner

Because of the need to wear masks, we will not be able to share a meal together on Wednesday night. However, we do still have an important Church Conference filled with significant items to discuss. This meeting will be held in person in the Fellowship Hall at 6:00pm, with a Zoom option for those joining remotely. The agenda and Zoom details are listed further down in this newsletter.

### Regular Wednesday Night Dinners - Delayed

After this week, we had hoped to resume immediately our weekly Wednesday night dinners and programs. With this no longer feasible, our hope now is to resume Wednesday evening dinners/programs in October. We will reevaluate the COVID situation in late September and update our plans accordingly. ### Wearing Masks Inside

In keeping with the advice of the CDC, we are resuming our requirement that people wear masks inside at UBC. This applies both to vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals. If you forget your mask on Sunday morning or need a new one, both disposable and homemade masks are available in the narthex. (Thank you to our sewing volunteers for providing masks we can distribute.) Of course, worship will also continue to be broadcast on the radio and live-streamed on YouTube and Facebook.

### Sunday Bible Study

Not everyone is ready to resume in-person Sunday Bible Study, so we will offer an online adult Bible Study option each week, beginning September 5, for anyone who would like to participate.

## Deacon Emeritus

The designation of Deacon Emeritus recognizes Deacons whose service and contributions have been exemplary. The Active Deacons have nominated five candidates to be presented for congregational approval at the next Church Conference (Aug. 18). Each week, we will highlight one or two of these candidates in The Word.

## Eldon Wood

Eldon grew up in Albemarle County attending Chestnut Grove Baptist Church where he was baptized and became a deacon. He also served as a deacon at Downtown Baptist, where he and Martha met and were married, and at Fair Park Baptist, both in Alexandria. Eldon and Martha joined UBC in 1979, and Eldon was involved in church leadership until his death in 2005. He served three terms as a deacon at UBC including being deacon chair. He was a valued Sunday School teacher and used his architectural skills with UBC's building renovation in the 1980s. Eldon was also involved in denominational life, serving as moderator of both the Mount Vernon and Albemarle Associations and as a trustee of Southern Baptist Theological Seminary during the turbulent period of the 1980s. He and Martha were involved in the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship from its formation.

## Alba's Retirement Celebration Postponed

Sadly, with the surging Delta variant of COVID-19, we will not be able to hold our celebration of Alba's ministry on September 26 as we had hoped.
