## “Dinner with Andrew”

During July, we have been looking at food insecurity in our worship services, and we have been putting our faith into action (James 2:14). Last Sunday, we learned a new hymn, “[When the Poor Ones.](#)” Since we are going to sing it again this week, take a moment and visit [this link](#) to hear it again.

So far, we have focused our attention on two projects: Venable bags and the freeze-drying program. However, one of the members of our church family has been raising funds to address food insecurity every year since July 2001. On January 1, 2001, Colleen Baber’s son Andrew choked on a gummy candy and did not survive. He had been working at Domino’s Pizza at the time, and his coworkers wanted to do something to honor his memory. They chose a food drive which fit well with honoring Andrew because few people liked to eat more than he did. Thus, “Dinner with Andrew” began.

This year is the twenty-second year Colleen has been collecting donations in Andrew’s memory. In 2020, she switched from collecting and sorting food to taking donations for food gift cards. She gives these cards to families in extreme need through The Jefferson Area Food Bank, The Salvation Army, The Emergency Food Bank, and ARC. We can help address food insecurity and be the hands and feet of Christ by supporting this ministry.
