You Are Welcome Here (Part 5) & the Saph's Invitation

Did someone say JARC? Last week, I wrote that in 2024 the Joint Administrative Review Committee will evaluate our structure and suggest any necessary changes. By June 1, 2024, the Deacons and Church Council will nominate a group of people to perform this function. Looking at organizational structures might not be the most exciting task in UBC life in 2024, but it's an incredible opportunity. JARC can codify changes that promote being a more welcoming and life-giving family of faith.

Last Sunday, I asked my Sunday school class what gave them the most joy in their faith. Here are some of their answers: prayer, reading daily devotions and scripture, worship, being together in our class, visiting church members, spending time together, and singing familiar hymns. No one mentioned committee meetings or church conferences. Is there a way that we can make the institutional part of *being church more efficient?*

I submit the answer is, "Yes!" What if, instead of over 70 slots to fill (committees, councils, deacons, officers, etc.), we reduced it to 29? Currently, some people fill multiple slots, not because they love meetings, but because they know there is work associated with being a family of faith. What would it be like if we had 12 deacons, 12 members of church council, and 5 people on a nominating committee? The congregation could elect deacons (like we currently do), and the deacons choose the nominating committee (like it is now). Then, the nominating committee's only responsibility would be to choose 4 new

Being more welcoming goes beyond structural changes. It's up to us. We all know people, and if we look for the opportunities, we can invite the people in our orbit to join our family of faith.
