Music Ministry

Over this past year, the Music Minister Search Committee has been working hard to find the person God is leading to UBC. The committee consists of Lily Gregg, chairperson, Robby Gough, Larry Johnson, Joyce Martin, Rachel Miller, Brian Mulcahy, Diane Mundell, and Sheri Owen. While Rev. Susan Deal has done an amazing job, and many of us wish she felt a calling to stay here permanently, we respect her desire to retire.

At times, the committee hasn't received qualified applicants. At other times, we haven't had any. Then, in early May, we placed an ad with the American Choral Directors Association. Within a week, we had 4 quality applicants. After another week, we had several more. The committee sent questionnaires to a total of 6 applicants, held an initial zoom interview with 4, and invited one for an in-person interview.

During the interview, the committee realized that they needed to focus more attention on the ministerial aspect of this calling. The person, while a talented musician and lovely human being, did not feel called to music ministry.

Interim Associate Minister

In May, the Church Council approved the creation of an Interim Associate Minister position. The goal of this position is to fill some of the gaps left by recent staff changes and help build our children and youth ministries. The Personnel Committee was intentional in leaving some of the tasks open-ended so we could adapt the position to the person God leading to us, but finding someone who could hit the ground running is a priority.

A few weeks ago, we received two promising resumes. After interviewing both candidates, we are excited to be moving forward with one of them. She will focus her attention on children and youth ministries. Although her initial covenant with the church will be through August 2025, she is eligible to be considered for the openended position of Associate Minister. You will hear more about her in the coming weeks.

For now, please pray for the Search Committee and lay leadership. We are all trying to discern God's will and direction for UBC, and we covet your prayers.
